#### How to Register:

- 1. Go to https://prescott.hotlunches.net.
- 2. Click the "REGISTER" menu at the top right-hand corner to sign up. Our school code is PLCHL.
- 3. Enter your name, email address and phone, then a user id that you will use for access to the hot lunch application. Enter a password and then enter it again to verify that it is correct.
- 4. Once registered, you will be logged into the website
- 5. Please add your students by clicking on the "STUDENTS" button below or the "PROFILE" menu tab in order to proceed. Once your students have been added to the system you will be able to place lunch orders immediately by clicking the "Order" button below each child's name.
- 6. Set up a Paypal account to pay by credit card online or wait for a cash day which will be posted prior to date.
