By playing on a Prescott Learning Centre team, I acknowledge that I am a leader and an ambassador for Prescott Learning Centre. I am expected to be a role model in my actions and attitudes on and off the court.

On The Court

- By joining the team, I have made a commitment to attend practice and games and display good sportsmanship. If I am going to be late or absent for a practice or game, I will let my coach know in person, by email or by phone as early as possible. I will not send a message with a teammate to the coach.
- I will try my best to help my team. That means working hard and being supportive, whether or not I am in the starting lineup.
- I will try my best, win or lose. Winning is the goal of games but losing teaches valuable lessons too. It helps us know what we need to work on and helps deal with setbacks later in life.
- If I am injured and unable to be an active participant in practice or a game, I will still attend so I can learn with and support my teammates.
- I will refrain from the use of inappropriate language at all times. I will not sound angry or frustrated when advising teammates during games. People will react best when I speak in a pleasant tone.
- I will help a teammate who is angry at teammates, referees or coaches calm down.
- I will show respect to game officials, coaches, opponents and spectators. In general, I should be intense playing the game but calm when my emotions start to get the best of me. Everyone is doing the best they can at tasks that are difficult.



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Off the Court

- I will be respectful to staff, students and the environment at all times.
- I will follow school expectations at all times.
- I will work hard to complete all my assignments and homework.
- I will not disrupt the learning of others in class.
- I will attend all my classes and be on time for school
