## **Prescott Weekend Update**



March 10th, 2024

Good Afternoon PLC Families:

It seems a bit odd that here in March we are already asking you to register your child for the 2024-2025 school year. How come so early? For one, PSD has one of the largest student transportation systems in the province moving over 7 500 students a day. Keep in mind that PSD works with the Evergreen Catholic system as well as several local private schools transporting these students as well. The system must balance urban and rural pick up and drop off spots throughout Parkland County with a variety of bus contractors, student travel times to over 30 schools, all while keeping the system on time and on budget. It is, to say the least, complex. While there will always be residents moving in and moving out over the summer, registering before the March 22nd deadline will go a long way in avoiding frustrating transportation delays and glitches when school starts in the fall.

At the school level, having accurate student registration numbers is invaluable in planning for the next school year. As a school we have worked hard to keep class sizes comparatively small in comparison with other school jurisdictions. With over 95% of the <a href="school's budget">school's budget</a> devoted to staffing, accurate registration information is crucial in ensuring not only that class sizes are balanced across grades, but also that the composition of classes within grades related to diverse student learning needs are balanced and matched with educational assistant support. Having accurate student numbers and information makes this task much more effective.

With the Prescott area being a rapidly growing community, in order to avoid ballooning class sizes we also need to build extra capacity to accommodate new arrivals into our catchment area (we're not sure where, or even how valid the information is, but I have heard that Spruce Grove has led the province in housing starts for four years in a row. But don't quote me on that). Keep in mind that from June 2023 to February 2024 the PLC student population grew by nearly 40 students. We anticipate that this number will increase even further before the end of the school year.

In light of these additional students, it is noteworthy that schools and school divisions are funded based on their student count on September 30th of each school year and growing school divisions like PSD are already faced with reduced per student funding due to the Weighted Moving Average finance model from the provincial government. This means that having these student registration numbers in March and April not only allows us to accommodate for this growth throughout the school year, but it also allows us to allocate our most valuable school resource, our teachers and educational assistants, in a manner that best serves your child(ren) for the 24-25 school year.

If you have yet to do so, I'll ask that you take a moment over the next few days to log in to your PowerSchool parent portal and click on the RSVP tab on the left hand side (unfortunately, the phone app will currently not allow you to register your child(ren); please use a browser such as Google or Microsoft Edge to complete the registration). If your student is new to the Division, you will need to go to our website and complete the NEW STUDENT REGISTRATION at: <a href="https://www.psd.ca/schools/registration">https://www.psd.ca/schools/registration</a>. I have included detailed registration below in the 'New and Updated Information' section of this memo. If you have any questions or need assistance




