5. Trustee Report: Trustee Montgomery

- January 21, 2025 Board Meeting
- Quarterly Financial Report: The Board received the financial report as of November 30, 2024 with the following information: Revenue to date: \$42.3million; Expenditures to date: \$39.7million. A forecasted surplus for this fiscal year is \$575,000 by August 31, 2025, with plans to move \$681,000 to capital reserves. The board spent part of its capital reserves last year to move forward with projects that were unlikely to be funded by the provincial government (ex. Tomahawk Gymnasium Renovation) and further capital reserve funds will likely be needed when the new Spruce Grove High School is built.
- Special Board Meeting: The board met on January 14, 2025 to approve a recommendation to accept and ratify a contract with the International Union of Operating Engineers (i.e. caretakers/maintenance workers supporting our buildings). The terms of the agreement can be found on our website and includes a 3% increase each year from September 1, 2024 (retroactive), to and including September 1, 2027.
- Literacy and Numeracy Report: Each year the board receives an update on the current assessment information on literacy and numeracy. This report informs the board on the outcome of targeted supports in these areas. There is a continued need to address the impact of Covid

restriction closures of schools on the cohort of students currently in grades 4-6.

 Parent Engagement Feedback Summary: The division held a parent engagement evening on November 27th, 2024 to discuss education and school culture specific to learners in grades 4-6. The summary of notes from that evening is available for review and comments can be directed to board@psd.ca.
